## GENERAL INFO

- Please notify your child's homeroom teacher as well as the school office when your child will be absent, coming late, or dismissing early from school. We also need to have the correct documentation on appointments, illnesses, etc. so we will be asking if the information is not provided.
- Reminder that your child must be fever free WITHOUT fever reducing meds for 24 hours before they can return to school. A fever is defined as 100 degrees or above. Also, if your child vomits they must stay home for 24 hours after the event.

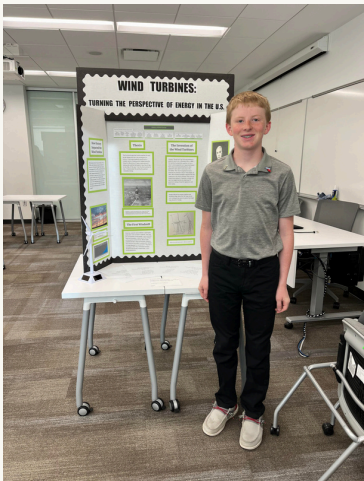
