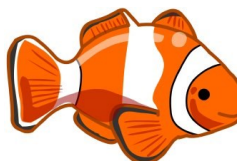

Lenten Practices and Responsibilities:

The season of Lent began February 14th, Ash Wednesday, and will conclude with the beginning of the Triduum, March 29. Ash Wednesday, February 14th, and Good Friday, March 30th are days of fast for those 18 to 59 years of age (your 59th birthday begins your 60th year). Fasting is observed by one/ordinary full meal and two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength for the obligation of one's circumstance. No eating between meals. All Fridays of Lent and Ash Wednesday are days of abstinence from meat for those 14 years of age and older. There is no upper age limit for abstinence.

Just a Reminder: On Fridays during Lent, when school is in session, St. Rose staff and students hold Stations of the Cross in St. Rose Church at 3:00 PM. The public is welcome to join us for this special time of reflection.

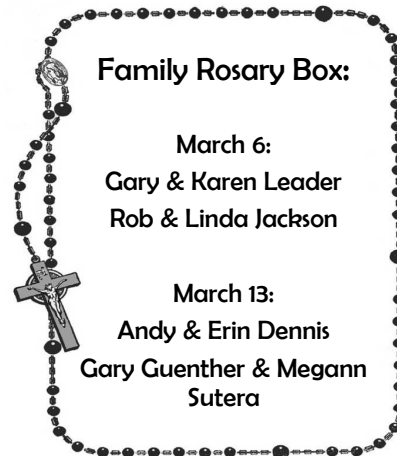

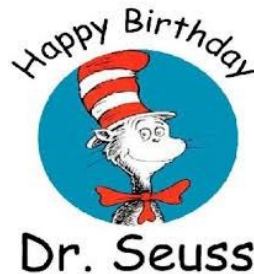
