GENERAL INFO

- Please notify your child's homeroom teacher as well as the school office when your child will be absent, coming late, or dismissing early from school. We also need to have the correct documentation on appointments, illnesses, etc. so we will be asking if the information is not provided.

LENTEN PRACTICES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14th, and concludes with the beginning of the Triduum, March 28. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, March 29, are days of fast for those 18 to 59 years of age (your 59th birthday begins your 60th year). Fasting is observed by one/ordinary/full meal and two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength for the obligation of one's circumstance. No eating between meals. All Fridays of Lent and Ash Wednesday are days of abstinence from meat for those 14 years of age and older. There is no upper age limit for abstinence. Parents, please encourage your child(ren) to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. There will be meatless options, as well as meat options, offered through the school lunch program.

Please join us Fridays during Lent at 3pm for Stations of the Cross.
