ST. ROSE OF LIMA PARISH PRESCHOOL POLICIES

GENERAL

Registration paperwork must be forwarded to the school prior to the acceptance of the child. Phone calls will not be accepted.

Preschool hours will be from 8:00 A.M. – 11:15 A.M. for morning preschool and from 12:15 P.M. to 3:30 P.M. for the afternoon preschool. Please do not drop off your children before preschool hours.

If there is a late start at the catholic/public school, there will be no morning preschool. If there is an early dismissal, there will no afternoon preschool.

Parking for preschool parents is allowed on the West side of the Preschool building on 6th Street, in front of St. Rose Rectory on 5th St., or on the North Side of St. Rose Church parking lot. Please do not park in front of the rectory garages.

TUITION

Tuition is billed beginning with the August tuition. Monthly payments are due on the 15th of each month beginning in September through May. If payments are not made on a monthly basis, please call the pastor, the facilitator or the parish bookkeeper at 388-4393 to make other arrangements.

Checks should be made payable to St. Rose of Lima Parish Preschool.

A \$30.00 fee will be assessed on all returned checks. After a second returned check all future tuition payments must be made in cash or money orders.

Checks may be deposited at the head teacher's office or mailed to the preschool 1302 W. 5th St., Crofton, NE. 68730. DO NOT give your check to the teacher or send it in with your child.

There will be no refunds due to absences.

St. Rose Parish preschool program requires preschool tuition to be paid in full by January 1 and May 15. Families with delinquent tuition will not be allowed to return in the spring or fall semesters. In special circumstances, other arrangements can be made with the facilitator.

TUITION

Summary of the School Immunization Rules and Regulations 2017-2018

Student Age Group	Required Vaccines
Ages 2 through 5 years enrolled in a school based program not licensed as a child care provider	<p>4 doses of DTaP, DTP, or DT vaccine</p> <p>3 doses of Polio vaccine</p> <p>3 doses of Hib vaccine or 1 dose of Hib given at or after 15 months of age</p> <p>3 doses of pediatric Hepatitis B vaccine</p> <p>1 dose of MMR or MMRV given on or after 12 months of age</p> <p>1 dose of varicella (chickenpox) or MMRV given on or after 12 months of age. Written documentation (including year) of varicella disease from parent, guardian, or health care provider will be accepted.</p> <p>4 doses of pneumococcal or 1 dose of pneumococcal given on or after 15 months of age</p>
Students entering school (Kindergarten or 1 st Grade depending on the school district's entering grade)	<p>3 doses of DTaP, DTP, DT, or Td vaccine, one given on or after the 4th birthday</p> <p>3 doses of Polio vaccine</p> <p>3 doses of pediatric Hepatitis B vaccine or 2 doses of adolescent vaccine if student is 11-15 years of age</p> <p>2 doses of MMR or MMRV vaccine, given on or after 12 months of age and separated by at least one month</p> <p>2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) or MMRV given on or after 12 months of age. Written documentation (including year) of varicella disease from parent, guardian, or health care provider will be accepted. If the child has had varicella disease, they do not need any varicella shots.</p>
Students entering 7 th grade	<p>Must be current with the above vaccinations</p> <p>AND receive</p> <p>1 dose of Tdap (contain Pertussis booster)</p>
Students transferring from outside the state at any grade	Must be immunized appropriately according to the grade entered.

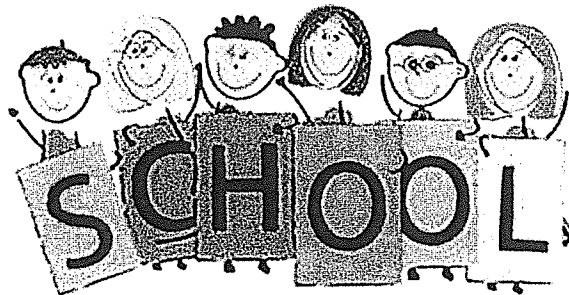

Who is ready for preschool?

When checking if a child is ready for preschool, examine how the child is developing socially, emotionally, physically, and cognitively rather than if they know a certain skill or not. Here are a few questions to consider when thinking about your child going to preschool.

- Self-sufficiency: How well does your child do at simple tasks by themselves such as putting on shoes, washing hands, or cleaning up toys?
- Ease of separation: How well does your child do when time is spent away from you?
- Independence: How does your child do at playing independently without parents? How does your child do at simple tasks without assistance.
- Ability to focus on group activities: How well does your child sit and participate in activities such as listening to a story, singing a song, or working on an art project?
- Comfort with routine and transitions: Would your child be able to move from one activity to the next with comfort? For example, moving from Center Time which is free play to clean up time.
- Stamina: Would your child be able to handle lots of activities without being overwhelmed and tired?
- Your own needs and feelings: What is your gut feeling as their parent?

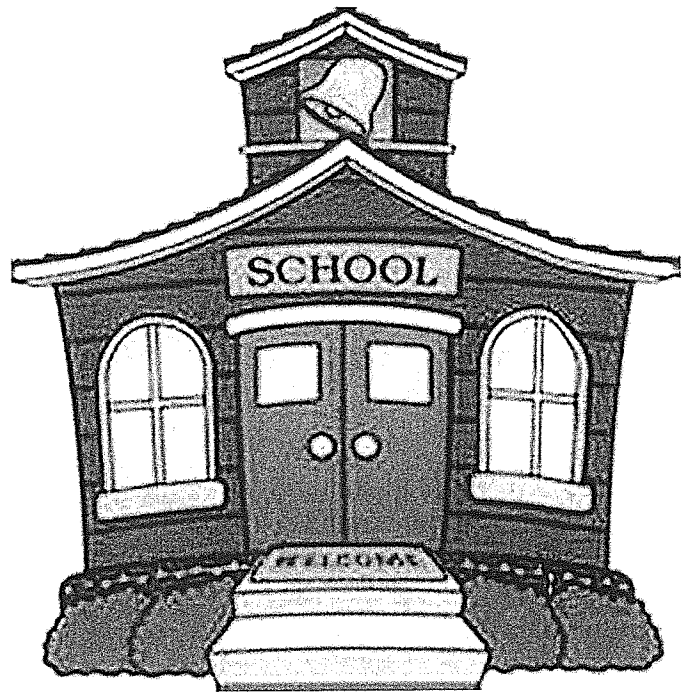
